

Conceptualized under our Fannuverin Fathuruverinnah initiative, Suvāsthi Gallery invites you to explore curated collections and retail spaces that represent the true essence of Maldives.

In the ancient Maldivian language (boadha bas), "Suvāsthi" is a noun meaning "expression of happiness." Like Oaga, Suvāsthi Gallery emerged from an intentional creative process rooted in rediscovering our heritage and understanding the essence of home. Inspired by Maldives' rich history as a thriving ocean kingdom, Suvāsthi Gallery showcases the work of exceptionally talented artists at Oaga Art Resort.

Our 2024/2025 exhibition explores three distinct themes: Dreams, Intimate Reflections, and Sacred Realms. Each theme is brought to life across five Veyoge Gallery Pool Villas, featuring 10 captivating pieces in each villa. The exhibition draws inspiration from the ancient Maldivian folktale of Khalid and Sitti, whose love story resonates with dreams, introspection, and a connection to the sacred.
